- Create signup genius/assign tasks and roles (President, VP)
- Send emails/communication to the group (President)
- Actively participate in the meetings (All)
- Create and send meeting minutes (Secretary)
- Actively participate in the events , assist KEC in any chores including food serving(All)
- On the event day, help with the set up, conduct the event and help with the clean up (All)
- Collect the money for bake sales/any other fundraising.(Treasurer)
